Minutes: Minutes were reviewed and a motion was made to approve the minutes from the March greens meeting by Gayle Wilcox and seconded by Lance Levine. Motion carries with no nays.

Greens Report: Jason said this has been the wettest winter since 1993. Needless to say he is behind schedule due to the weather. The greens have been punched and sanded. There will be more sanding done in the future. When it dries out he will be doing more mowing and winter clean up on the fairways and rough. He has ordered a NO PARKING sign for the culvert area between holes 3-4. Jims Towing will also be installing a Tow sign for us at a cost of \$11.00. Jason and the crew will be re-routing the cart path between 7-8 to make it more manageable and safer. They will also be installing concrete triangles and logs along the path by the cart sheds on #9 to better distinguish the out of bounds area. Drainage is still poor on #6 and the pond is full to capacity so rain water is flowing onto course.

Pro Shop: Ron is glad to be back and excited to be here for the entire season start to finish. He has been working on the financials and training his staff. Elen and Nick did a great job during the winter months keeping the golfers out on the course. Ron is also working on a training manual and has presented to the greens committee for review before we present it to the board. We will be starting a new POS system soon that will better interact with the current QuickBooks program the association is using. This will be a better way to track purchases for the Pro Shop, Café and Inn sales. It will be more organized and make having Purchase Orders easier. Ron would like to hire one more full time staff and one part time staff with BOD approval. There will be more merchandise arriving soon thanks in part to the Magpies group for their generous donation of \$2000.00. Elen and Nick have been doing the re-gripping of clubs for members all winter and will continue to do so. Last Saturday's Glow Ball Tournament had 12 players and broken even on expenses. There will be a Masters Tournament on April 8th. Our first couples tournament will be held on April 15th. It will be a 9 hole scramble starting at 4:00. We are working on a new coupon special for the coming season.

Navy Project: Glen Z is working on the project and will report any new information at our next meeting.

Other Business: Jason is considering adding a 3rd tee box to all holes. We are looking for volunteers to adopt a fairway to help patching and seeding bare areas. Contact Jason or the greens committee if you live on a fairway and would like to participate.
