My name is Amy Sem. I have lived in Division 4 since 1996, both as a non-member and a member of the community. My daughter was born and raised in the LLCC.

Over the years, I have seen some things within the community that work, some that don't, and some that just need some improvement.

The current budget is "balanced," but I think we could improve it to actually cultivate a profit without ever increasing dues. I think this would make it easier to maintain our facilities without the picking and choosing what upkeep we can afford this year.

I believe that with a black and white adherence to our bylaws (not trying to use your own perception of it,) as well as a common sense approach, we could could once again be a thriving and cohesive community.

With the next generation of children in the area, I think we could improve some of the amenities to actually engage and give them something to do. Perhaps additional park areas - something non-existent in Div 4, where the kids play in the middle of intersections.
