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Treasurer's Report

November 30, 2011

A/R balance is \$392,297.38 > this amount includes \$54,172 water receivables, and \$10,133 from the stolen Masco Credit Card, for a net dues balance of \$327,992.

The \$327,922 includes 94 accounts who had not paid their current quarterly dues, and 154 accounts 90 days past due, these accounts are not in Legal (yet).

The top 5 Legal accounts total \$127,405 and the top ten legal accounts total \$165,249.

December 15, 2011

A/R balance is \$380,933.85 > this amount includes \$51,095 water receivables, and \$10,133 from the stolen Masco Credit Card, for a net balance of \$319,706, which is \$8286 Less then the November 30^{th} total.

The \$319,706 includes 58 accounts who have not paid their current quarterly dues (36 less then Nov 30th), and 148 accounts 90 days past due, (only 6 less then Nov. 30th)

The top 5 Legal accounts total \$127,284 and the top ten legal accounts total \$165,918, this shows very little change at this time.

We currently have commitments from foreclosing banks for payments in January for an approximate total of \$30,485, (this amount is for 4 accounts).

The plan in January is to hire a part time office person who will be tasked with accounts payable and collections by phone. The phone collections seem to work quite well with the last person who worked this position, it is hoped the same progress will be made by our new employee.
