Financial Update: Roger Milliman (CAM) reported that Restaurant revenue was up 41%, Café revenue was up 14%, and Lounge revenue was up 99% over previous year's revenue for the same month.

- Kristine will now be working 3 days per week (Thursday, Friday, Saturday);
- Nicky will serve as Lead on Wednesdays and Sundays
- Jon (Chef) reported that old menu will be updated with some new offerings—Smoked Salmon Dip replacing Hummus, Shrimp Louie, and a Blackened Rock Cod Sandwich
- A Kid's Menu is available—suggestion was made that this be used as an insert in regular menu (after perusal from Chef Jon) and then advertise on social media that the menu is available
- **GF (gluten free)** choices are now more readily available and labeled on menu
- A new menu is being updated for the Café—Brian and Kristine are working on it and will publish it next week
- Wine Tasting and Dinner will happen in June; currently reservations are 3 short of a sellout at \$70 per person; wines tasted during the event will be available for purchase that evening
- Possible **Karaoke Night** and **Game Night** may be offered on an alternating basis on Wednesday nights but nothing is set in stone
