- Checks written out of the mainline and well accounts will now be accompanied by clear documentation as to what the money is used for.

#### WATER SYSTEM MANAGER'S REPORT: CHRIS MCMULLEN

- Managers' Report & Consumption Spreadsheet See attached consumption report.
  - Don and Chris are working on edits to the consumption report in efforts to create an accurate report.
  - Numerous leaks last month. Chris is repairing them and calculating the quantity to include int the Consumption Report.
  - Additionally, Chris is calculating the amount of water used during the system flushing to be included in the Consumption Report.

### 2) Project Status:

- Water Quality Testing Stations On hold until spring.
- **SCADA Upgrades** Chris is waiting for additional details from Coast Controls before writing a PAR.
- Elevated Storage Feasibility Study On hold until well assessment is completed.

### 3) Maintenance Status:

- **Equipment** Numerous leaks due to "O" rings malfunctioning during extreme cold weather. Chris will research to see if the "O" ring is a faulty product.
- PARS The Board is requesting and as per by-laws, they need the PARs two weeks prior to their meeting for thorough review before voting. Chris did not have the complete form for submitting PARS, he has been given the complete form to use from now on.

 Hydrant Testing and Maintenance – This will begin after #2 is fully operational, including SCADA control.

## 4) New Information:

- Chris is gathering information to replace well house doors. Well #2 will be the first one to be installed. Due to existing structures, the work will most likely be done by a contractor and not in-house.
- Picatti will be doing an on-site assessment February 22nd. Additionally, Chris will work with Picatti to gain clarity on the approved bid per the Board's request. Kelly will work with Chris and Picatti to review the work contract.

#### **FORGIVENESS**

There were no requests submitted for the committee to review.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

- 1) Water System Plan The plan is now with DOH for review. They should be done reviewing by the end of the month. Lake Limerick will then make edits as needed.
- **2)** Navy Water Line Easements Kelly is working with Doug Eklund to clarify the Navy's questions. Currently the project is in the Navy's hands. Kelly is monitoring the developments.
- 3) 2024 2025 Budget -
  - Meeting set March 13<sup>th</sup> @ 5:00 for the committee to begin work on the 2024 -2025 budget.
  - A bi-annual budget process will be assessed for future planning.

### **NEW BUISINESS**

- 1) SCADA The system is important because it enables the Water manager to remotely view and control the wells and gather real time data.
- **2) Pump House Wiring** Two contractors have submitted good, comparable bids. Chris will move forward with the project, motion and PAR not needed for this project due to cost.
