The Greens Committee has been working with a golf course architect to come up with ideas to make our course better. Jason has wanted to redesign the 7th green since he arrived at Lake Limerick 5 years ago. So the committee is working on fundraising to get this project completed. We are asking or hole sponsorships as well as a nice friendly competition between our Huskies and Cougar fans. We have raised over \$5000 to date.
