Greens Report: As you can see the frost season is starting creep in. Ground temperatures are still up so the grass is still growing, which makes us busy trying to control it.

The golf course is in great shape going into the winter season and will come out even healthier than years before

THINGS ACCOMPLISHED:

- » Drain on #9 is working like it should now. No sign of holding water.
- » New signage for 90-degree rule, rough only, & cart path only.
- » Removed stump next to patio area.
- Fall fairway sanding finished.
- S Irrigation pumps have been pulled and being repaired and upgraded at this time.
- » Newer more durable locks on bathroom doors were installed for #5 restroom.
- All drains have been cleared out around course before the heavier rains came.
- » New blind wall/display board for porta potty #3/9. (This will display cafe/proshop#, tournaments and results, things going on in the community, menus, etc.)

Things to accomplish November/December:

- Keep light sanding greens to improve playability on then thru the winter and early spring.
- Swinging door closure #5 restroom
- Repair, level, enhance for a temporary green #7.
- Elevate, level black tee boxes for seeding in early spring.
- Install shrubbery up #7 cart-path.
- / • • Dead tree removal around course.
- Build yardage signs for black tees.
- Enhance landscape into Lake limerick.

#7 Green complex rebuild: Things I will have to take care of before (D)day.

- * Remove and store tan sand from bunkers.

- « Fill in bunkers
- " Locate, save, cap irrigation.
- * Locate place to stock pile materials.
- * Grow in nursery green for sod.
- * Enhance a temporary green in the fairway.
