Golf revenue increased for the second consecutive month over last year's revenue. We have 17 working golf carts at this time but they are old and not reliable. Upcoming specials will be a 2 for one golf special starting in the middle of September and the \$20 dollar family special will continue.

Both Jason and Elen reported there has been an issue of kids riding their bikes on the cart paths as well as playing on the greens and fairways.

There was discussion on personal cart identification so they can easily be reported is breaking the rules. This issue will go a subcommittee for further review as well as the need for more Marshalls on the course.

Cam Report: Roger reported revenue was \$1200 over last year for the month of July.

Chair Comments: Vern reported golf has been great this summer and with the Greens and Inn committee Marketing things are looking up.

Marketing: Nancy reported the new Lake Limerick 2020 Calendars will be ready for purchase next week. They will sell for \$15 each. There is a new brochure highlighting Lake Limerick now available.
