



## Lake Limerick COVID-19 Golf Policy

To minimize contact and to limit COVID-19 in accordance with the Governor's requirements, the following Policies are in effect until further notice:

1. All golfers call the pro shop 360-426-6290 or email [elen@lakelimerick.com](mailto:elen@lakelimerick.com) to make a Tee time.
  - A log is maintained for all customers, including contact information.
  - Tee times are available with 10-minute spacing between groups.
  - Foursomes are allowed if they are from the same household. Otherwise, no more than two players from separate households per tee time.
  - Restrict play to one rider per power cart unless two players are from the same household.
  - Annual golf members will report directly to tee #1 without entering the pro shop at their designated starting time.
  - LLCC Members and Annual golf members are permitted to make standing tee times.
  - No refunds for paid golf Annuals
2. Paying golfers are to pay over the phone when making tee times.  
Credit Card ONLY transactions – NO CASH
3. For golfers that need to enter the pro shop, we require you to wear a face mask for the safety of yourself and staff.  
Staff are required to wear PPE.
4. No group meetings allowed in the pro shop without a reserved time.
5. Carts will be sanitized after each usage.  
Pull carts are available and will be sanitized after each usage.  
No rental clubs available at this time.
6. Kiosk for posting scores is currently closed.  
Staff will post your scores by emailing [elen@lakelimerick.com](mailto:elen@lakelimerick.com) to avoid personnel contact.
7. No pins in practice putting area.  
No range balls provided.
8. Greens
  - Cup liners are modified for no touch.
  - The flagstick remains in at all times. Do not touch nor remove.
  - Sand rakes, ball washers, and other touch points are removed.
9. For daily cart rules, please refer to sign located on #1 tee  
(Cart path only, Rough only, 90-degree rule)
10. Refrain from grabbing any golf balls or clubs other than your own.
11. Do not congregate around flagstick or teeing space.
12. The course is Marshalled to ensure physical distancing by reminding golfers, and where necessary, warning repeat offenders.
13. Maintain a 6-foot distance between others.
