Vern call the meeting to order with a Yahoo the Golf Course will be opening for business May 5th!

Greens: Jason reported the crew has been busy sanding fertilizing and mowing the greens and fairways. They have been working on the irrigation system also. With only 3 workers they worked hard trying to get all the jobs done in a timely manner. The part time workers have since returned and all the others jobs are getting done. Cleaning up the rough and mowing so we are ready for next Tuesday.

Pro Shop: Mark and Elen are back in the office getting ready for the reopening of the golf course. Members have been calling and emailing for Tee Times. Members and Guest are being asked to wear Masks when entering the Pro Shop and payment will be done by credit card only. A new list of rules for Golf play and policies has been published and distributed. A notice will be sent out regarding all walkers and such that Golf will begin again on Tuesday May 5th. Signs will be painted on the cart path for the direction walkers should go. Always away from the golf play so you can see the golfer and they can see you. We will have 6 Marshalls out this year to help direct those who are confused. The new rules also state there will be only 2 somes at this time in separate carts unless you live in the same household. Tee times will be spaced 10 minutes apart. There will be no Golf Refunds given as this has been the standing policy. Men's club has been canceled for this season and the Women's league has been postponed until June and will be reevaluated at that time.

CAM: Roger stated the financials have been looking ok despite the close down. Café sales are up 26% over last year. Revenues are down and golf annuals are down at this time. The cleaning company will be called to start up business again to keep our facilities clean for customers. The Pro Shop is in the process of hiring a third person to work with Elen and Mark.

Marketing: Ads will be coming out in May. Coupons were discussed and will be coming out later in the summer.

New Business: Golf Policies and Procedures during Covid 19.(See attached) No Golf Refunds for the weeks missed during the shutdown will be issued. There was a lot of discussion regarding this matter and there has been a policy in the past that there would not be any refunds for annuals.

The New Golf Carts were delivered the day before the shut down and are ready for Golf on Tuesday. Score cards will be available in the mail boxes on holes number 1 and 2. Members and Public are asked to call or email the pro shop for tee times and to prepay. Do not arrive too early as there is to be no lingering or congregating around the tee box or Pro Shop. Arrive and go straight to tee box.

For members or public who do not follow the new rules that are in place call the Pro Shop and report the activity. They will then handle it or pass it to the CAM who will take the next action before it goes to the BOD for action. We should always for the chain of command.
