Roger and Josh are working on a schedule for the Café now that golf will be opening. There is a limited staff so hours are an issue. The numbers are looking good for food purchases during this

stay at home order and curb side pickup for the Inn and Café is increasing. We will have more information at a later date.

The County has signed off on our new deck permits so we are moving on to the next phase of the Board approving starting the contract bids for construction. All this is good news.

Marketing and advertising are going forward with Nancy and Elen's hard work.

Mother's Day and Father's Day Brunch out of the Café are in the works.

When we do open for sit down meals there will be limited seating and masks should be worn when coming into the facilities.

The Inn Committee will hold another meeting in early June to discuss the Governors next phase of reopening.
