Greens Report: Golf course looks good. Work continues on cutting the greens and fairways. Repairing some parts of irrigation system as the system we have is quite old. There have been issues with the golf course equipment and one mower has broken down. We are looking for a replacement. The lease for all equipment will be up in November. Jason is working on the budget and Capital Projects for 2021.

Pro Shop: Elen reported revenue is up from last year. The Wednesday tournaments are bringing in more golfers and money. There are more Wednesday tournaments scheduled for the summer. Golf lessons will begin June 15th, Men's, Women's and Youth.

Café: We will begin seating inside and out beginning June 6th with restrictions.

Cam: Roger reported golf is up 1% in revenue over last year. Work has begun on the budget for next year. We are scheduled to participate in the Chamber Tournament at Alderbrook again and will have a table at hole # 16. Event will take place on August 21st if all goes well.

There was a long discussion on walkers on the golf course and the rules that need to be followed. Most members abide by the rules but there are a few who are not. The policies will be given out by the Pro Shop and the Marshalls on the course when they see a problem. As members we must act responsibly when talking to others regarding the rules. If a problem arises please notify the Pro Shop and they will address the problem and pass it on the Cam if needed.

We will be moving into Phase 3 soon so there will be new rules coming from the Governor. When the new information is received the information will be passed on to the membership.

Marketing: Coupons will now be in the Journal for golf and a cart. Elen will be taking over most of the Marketing plans for now as Nancy has started a new job. The Greens committee would like to thank you Nancy for all your hard work.

Navy: Steve Whitehouse our attorney has received information from the Navy regarding the Trestle project. A discussion took place with committee regarding this matter. More information will follow.
