Guest Question/Issue for Committee:

• Div 5 Lot 055: Building a 6ft fence on property. Feedback provided by Architectural Committee (AC) to create a design that will be compliant. Suggestion also given to have the final panel of fencing that is on front-side portion of property be reduced to 4ft. Owners will be submitting permit application with payment to the office next week.

- Compliance Committee Question
 - Div 3 Lot 501: 271 E. Shetland owners seem to be working on septic and with backhoe.
 No permit needed if doing maintenance or "fixing" septic issues. Will continue to monitor and remind owners that permits will be needed if building a new structure.

OLD BUSINESS:

 Architectural and Compliance Committee Secretary - Updated job description, need to post on LLCC website and Mason County. AC work with Dean Dyson when applications come in.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Motion made by Chris J. and second by Sharon H. to request to replace the current Lake
 Limerick map on the LLCC website that is the Water Department's map, be replaced with a
 map that has dimensions of each lot. AC has a copy of this map that can be used.
- Reviewed Construction Agreement for LLCC Inn deck.
 - Observations by AC:
 - Page 8: DECK: section 1.2.6 "Support columns shall consist of eight 6x6 Alaskan yellow cedar (AYC); each post shall be set under each glulam member, attached to concrete slab with brackets, epoxy set." This should be noted so members are aware that the new deck will have 8 posts coming down to help support the deck. This may be a visual impairment between the windows in the restaurant/lounge and the lake.
 - Working hours for construction will be 7AM 6PM Monday Friday
