SECURITY UPDATE

Dear LLCC Community Members,

You have requested **increased security** at Lake Limerick and the Board has good news to share. Starting July 1 during Lake Limerick Daze, you will see more security in our neighborhoods and parks.

Quick Facts:

- The Board has directed an increase in security patrol services
- Security will be randomly paroling the community common assets including parks
- Security staff will ask to see your LLCC **ID card** to confirm your membership
- All members must have their official LLCC ID cards on them

What to expect:

All members, youth included, will be expected to have their official **Lake Limerick ID card** with them at all times. This is especially important when using the parks, beaches and Inn grounds that are private for Membership only use.

Why ID cards matter: The security staff will rely on your ID card to confirm your membership. It is **not** enough to say, "I've lived here for 20 years!", "I live on Saint Andrews," or to share your Lot/Division number.

Doing their job: The security staff are working to enforce the LLCC rules. This may include such things as evicting trespassing or unauthorized persons from the property and requesting law enforcement to arrest persons committing a criminal violation.

Actions you can take:

- 1. Pick up your official LLCC ID card from the office.
- 2. Talk with your family members and kids. Let them know they must have their ID cards on them at all times. People without their ID cards will be asked to leave beaches and parks.
- 3. If stopped by security, or park hosts, be understanding. They are doing a job that we all asked them to perform.
- 4. If security asks you or a friend to leave, please do so without issue. Concerns and complaints can be shared with the Community Association Manager (CAM) in the office.
- 5. Read the community by-laws and governing documents by opening <u>Association Documents Lake Limerick Country Club</u> to know the HOA rules.
