June Operations—Chef Jon

- The Wine Cooler is broken and cannot be repaired so a new one has been approved by the Office; Beer Cooler in the Café is also broken
- Wednesday night dinner attendance has been strong; Thursday nights are great!
- Father’s Day BBQ at the Inn will feature Ribs and a Monster Burger as well as a special drink
- Food for the Shamrock Golf Tournament will be a Taco Bar
- Staffing at the restaurant is good and now instead of having to search for applicants when workers are needed, people are submitting applications
- Nikki is no longer the FOH (Jon is assuming those duties) but working as a Server only
- Sandy Nelson volunteered to coordinate volunteer help in the restaurant as needed (she will work with Jon to establish the process including what help he needs)

Recap of May Events

- Karaoke—event was well attended and received; food sales (grilled hotdogs/chips) were less than expected; the event was moved indoors to the dining room because of wet weather; an extra bartender was added to help with service

Future Summer Events
