- Chairperson Comments: Thanking committee members/friends for their outstanding performances and delivery of the Garage Sale and Garage Mahal music event. Both events were well received with MANY saying it was the fun event of the Summer. Special Thanks to Barney and Sherry Hartley for bringing the Community this FUN event. The band agrees to perform in the future for our community.
  - Report from Chef Jon - sales are up, staffing has improved with the addition of a dishwasher and pantry chef. However, the restaurant still lacks a "Front of House" person. The hiring process is lengthy. Hope remains that this position will be filled sooner than later. Chef Jon met with our general manger Shannon Ramos. A Kitchen Budget Process was discussed at length. To date, there is no budget allotted for the kitchen. Chef Jon was encouraged to increase revenue by 15% before further budget and kitchen needs are addressed.

- Chairman's Comments on recent meeting with the GM. Paul Wagner met with Shannon to discuss the role of the Inn Committee here at LLCC. Increasing Social Memberships was discussed as a way to increase revenue and further increase usage of our amenities. Paul applauded our excellent Chef Jon for continuing to offer excellent culinary choices.
- Newly found Board Member Support for Inn Committee – Paul Wagner shared that he is seeing increased support from our board members where it concerns the work of the Inn Committee to bring fun for all ages in creative ways to our community. We appreciate their support.
- Lake Limerick Daze security concerns discussion and any other comments- The committee with research and explore ways to provide much needed security personal to protect and manage traffic on St. Andrews. We will also post our parade permit in a prominent visible way at the beginning of the parade route. We will reach out to the Sheriff to make them aware of our concerns and ask for their support going forward. Our shortcake sales came to \$600., our food sales came to \$900.
