 - Place orders for necessary parts and supplies to maintain equipment service.

- o Train staff on the proper use and operation of equipment.

5. Additional Duties:

- Maintain an orderly and efficient shop area.
- Regulate employees' use of equipment in the absence of the superintendent and assistant superintendent.
- o Perform other duties as directed by the superintendent.

- Knowledge of golf course equipment and machinery
