



Lake Limerick Lakes/Dams/Parks

News Update: April 2025

To help everyone enjoy a safe and relaxing time on the water and in our parks, we kindly ask everyone to be aware of the following information. Thank you!

Lake Fishing Season:

- Opening day of lowland lake fishing season is April 26th.
- Lake Limerick Country Club (LLCC) annual Lake Limerick Fishing Derby takes place on this day; tickets available [online](#) or in-person at Lake Limerick Market and Pro Shop.
- The Washington Dept of Fish and Wildlife will plant trout in Lake Limerick prior to the opening day of fishing.
- LLCC will fund a separate planting of larger trout on a similar schedule.
- Lake Leprechaun is a private LLCC lake, open year-round for members only (not part of the Derby).
- Members must register their boats with the office; non-members can only fish at Lake Limerick. [Vessel Registration Procedures & Forms - Lake Limerick Country Club](#)

Lake Usage:

- Lake rules and safety guidelines govern usage for swimming, canoeing, water skiing, etc. Please review the [Lake Rules & Safety Guidelines](#).
- Non-members can launch boats at Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife (WDFW) but can only fish; members must register boats and display registration stickers.
- Lake Patrol oversees compliance and educates violators in a positive way.

Lake Height Increase:

- Dam weir boards will be reinstalled in during April to raise both lakes to their summer levels.
- Members should move items near the lake edge to prevent loss.

Parks De-Winterized:

- All LLCC restrooms, except for Olde Lyme, and boat launch areas will open before the fishing season starts. Note: Banbury & Olde Lyme restrooms are open year-round during daylight hours. Olde Lyme restrooms are being remodeled and, therefore, closed until July 1, 2025.
- Our facilities staff are preparing the parks with general clean-up.
- The Anglia Park Host has arrived, and the remaining hosts are scheduled to arrive by mid-May.

Park Usage:

- Parks are for members and guests only; guest passes and/or membership cards are required while at the parks. Temporary guest passes can be requested from the office.

- Completion of Olde Lyme Restroom Upgrade for year-around usage.

- Resolving valve structure issues at Lake Leprechaun Dam.
